This year's event was more than double the size of prior years and featured 288 golfers. The Integra Telecom sponsored event has raised more than \$297,000 to date. This year's tournament took place at The Reserve Vineyards and Golf Club in Aloha, Ore., on July 30, and raised more than \$135,000 in proceeds for the foundation.
